  - a) Covid update
    - i. Policies for quarantine and isolation (https://www.seattleschools.org/news/quarantinerequirements/#:~:text=Quarantine%20should%20last%20for%2010,for% 20symptoms%20until%20day%2014):
      - 1. Isolation:
        - a. When test positive out for 5 days, return if still asymptomatic or if symptoms have significantly improved
      - 2. Quarantine (if close contact with someone who is positive)
        - a. Vaccinated Monitor
        - b. Unvaccinated out for 5 days, negative test to come back
    - ii. Contract tracing is changing a little
      - School is doing the notifications to the whole class if someone is positive (not district). Still notifying whole class, usually within a couple hours.
      - 2. Contact tracers (district and contracted) do the contact tracing. They are still actively doing this and working really hard.
      - 3. Note: YMCA definition of close contact is a little different than STEM
    - iii. Masks
      - 1. The school is providing KN95s to teachers; N95s to teachers who are in higher risk situations.
      - 2. The school has cloth and surgical masks available for kids.
    - iv. Testing

1. The school has both rapid and PCR tests. They are testing kids if there is a reason to (parent requests, kid had a symptom).
