 - (1) SPS has 9 fully funded RNs for 50,000 SPS students. We are at 68. Need to be at 105.
 - (2) State fully funds only a portion of custodians
 - (3) State only pays for 82M of 180M budget for special education
 - (4) Levies pass for a 3 year period. Asking for \$646.8M over three years (74 cents per \$1000 of assessed value) (current amount allowed under state law is 63 cents per \$1000. SPS is asking for 11 cents extra).

 - (a) Building projects, technology, academics/athletics (BTA)
 - (b) Staff recommends \$765M over 6 years
 - (i) Address all Priority 1 projects
 - (ii) 46 cents per \$1000k of appraised value
 - (iii) 3 cents mor than BTA IV in 2016
 - (iv) Technology amount doubles 2016 with 1:1 and other tech changes

 - a) Some schools are losing FTEs because enrollment is down. STEM is down about 30 students. District is trying to use funding to avoid staff adjustments. STEM isn't having staff adjustments.

 - (3) We are Tier 3 our school transportation will be maintained. May have more delays though.
